Mark 5:25 And there was a woman who had had a discharge of blood for twelve years, **26** and who had suffered much under many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was no better but rather grew worse. *English Standard Version*

Mark 5:27 She had heard the reports about Jesus and came up behind him in the crowd and touched his garment. **28** For she said, “If I touch even his garments, I will be made well.” **29** And immediately the flow of blood dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed of her disease. **30** And Jesus, perceiving in himself

that power had gone out from him, immediately turned about in the crowd and said, “Who touched my garments?” **31** And his disciples said to him, “You see the crowd pressing around you, and yet you say, ‘Who touched me?’” **32** And he looked around to see who had done it. **33** But the woman, knowing what had happened to her, came in fear and trembling and fell down before him and told him the whole truth. **34** And he said to her, “Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace, and be healed of your disease.” *English Standard Version*

Mark 6:3 Then they scoffed, **“He’s just a carpenter, the son of Mary and the brother of James, Joseph, Judas, and Simon. And his sisters live right here among us.”** They were deeply offended and **refused to believe in him.**
4 Then Jesus told them, “A prophet is honored everywhere except in his own hometown and among his relatives and his own family.” ***New Living Translation-SE***

Mark 6:5 And **because of** their unbelief, **he couldn’t do** any miracles among them except to place his hands on a few sick people and heal

them. **6** And he was amazed at their unbelief. Then Jesus went from village to village, teaching the people. *New Living Translation-SE*

Luke 5:17 One day as he was teaching, Pharisees and teachers of the law, who had come from every village of Galilee and from Judea and Jerusalem, were sitting there. And the power of the Lord was present for him to heal the sick. *New International Version*

Luke 5:18 Some men came carrying a paralytic on a mat and tried to take him into the house to lay him before Jesus. **19** When they could not find a way to do this because of the crowd, they went up on the roof and lowered him on his mat through the tiles into the middle of the crowd, right in front of Jesus. **20** When Jesus saw their faith, he said, “Friend, your sins are forgiven.” *New International Version*

Luke 5:21 The Pharisees and the teachers of the law began thinking to themselves, “Who is this fellow who speaks blasphemy? Who can

forgive sins but God alone?” *New International Version*

Matthew 9:23 When Jesus entered the ruler’s house and saw the flute players and the noisy crowd, *24* he said, “Go away. The girl is not dead but asleep.” But they laughed at him. *25* After the crowd had been put outside, he went in and took the girl by the hand, and she got up. *26* News of this spread through all that region. *New International Version*

*Matthew 9:27*As Jesus went on from there, two blind men followed him, calling out, “Have mercy on us, Son of David!” *28* When he had gone indoors, the blind men came to him, and he asked them, “Do you believe that I am able to do this?” “Yes, Lord,” they replied. *New International Version*

Matthew 9:29 Then he touched their eyes and said, “According to your faith will it be done to you”; *30* and their sight was restored. Jesus warned them sternly, “See that no one knows about this.” *31* But they went out and spread the

news about him all over that region. *New International Version*

Jesus redeemed Christians from the curse of the law

Galatians 3:13 But Christ has rescued us from the curse pronounced by the law. When he was hung on the cross, he took upon himself the curse for our wrongdoing. For it is written in the Scriptures, “Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree.” *14* Through Christ Jesus, God has blessed the Gentiles with the same blessing he promised to Abraham, so that we who are believers might receive the promised Holy Spirit through faith. *New Living Translation-SE*

Psalms 103:1 Praise the LORD, O my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name. *2* Praise

the LORD, O my soul, and **forget not all his benefits** **3** who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, **4** who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, **5** who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. *New International Version*

Jesus paid for you to be healed

Isaiah 53:4 Surely **our diseases he did bear**, and **our pains he carried**; whereas we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. **5** But **he was wounded** because of our transgressions, **he was crushed** because of our iniquities: the chastisement of our welfare **was upon him**, and **with his stripes we were healed**. *Hebrew Bible*

1 Peter 2:24 He personally carried our sins in his body on the cross so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. **By his wounds you are healed**. *New Living Translation-SE*

Jesus promised to meet your needs and bless

your giving

Philippians 4:18 I have received full payment and even more; I am amply supplied, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the gifts you sent. They are a fragrant offering, an acceptable sacrifice, pleasing to God. **19** And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus. ***New International Version***

Luke 6:38 Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.” ***New International Version***

Jesus set you free from sin

Romans 6:1 Well then, should we keep on sinning so that God can show us more and more of his wonderful grace? **2** Of course not! Since we have died to sin, how can we continue to live in it? ***New Living Translation-SE***
