## **Arguments against Speaking in other Tongues today**

1. Tongues were done away with when the Bible was written and the last Apostle of the Lamb died

Scriptures used to prove this point

1 Corinthians 13:8 Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away. 9 For we know in part and we prophesy in part, 10 but when perfection comes, the imperfect disappears. New International Version

1 Corinthians 13:12 Now we see but a poor reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known. New International Version

2. I already have the Holy Spirit if I'm a Christian

Scriptures used to prove this point

1 Corinthians 6:19 Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; New International Version

Acts 19:1 While Apollos was at Corinth, Paul took the road through the interior and arrived at Ephesus. There he found some disciples 2 and asked them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" New International Version

3. Its purpose is to speak a human language you don't know so you can share Christ with people

Scriptures used to prove this point

Acts 2:7 They were completely amazed. "How can this be?" they exclaimed. "These people are all from Galilee, 8 and yet we hear them speaking in our own native languages! New Living Translation-SE

1 Corinthians 14:22 So you see that speaking in tongues is a sign, not for believers, but for unbelievers. Prophecy, however, is for the benefit of believers, not unbelievers. New Living Translation SE

We also pray directly to God when we pray in other tongues

1 Corinthians 14:2 For anyone who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men <u>but to God</u>. Indeed, no one understands him; he utters mysteries with his spirit. New International Version

1 Corinthians 14:14 For if I pray in tongues, my spirit is praying, but I don't understand what I am saying. 14 Well then, what shall I do? I will pray in the spirit, and I will also pray in words I understand. I will sing in the spirit, and I will also sing in words I understand. New Living Translation SE

1 Corinthians 14:14 For if I pray in an [unknown] tongue, my spirit [by the Holy Spirit within me] prays, but my mind is unproductive [it bears no fruit and helps nobody] ... Amplified Bible

It plugs us into the power of the Holy Spirit, which builds us up

1 Corinthians 14:4 He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church. New International Version

1 Corinthians 14:4 A person who speaks in tongues is strengthened personally ... New Living Translation-SE

Jude 1:20 But you, dear friends, carefully **build yourselves up** in this most holy faith **by** praying in the Holy Spirit, *Message Bible* 

Acts 19:1 While Apollos was at Corinth, Paul took the road

through the interior and arrived at Ephesus. There he found some disciples 2 and asked them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" *New International Version*
